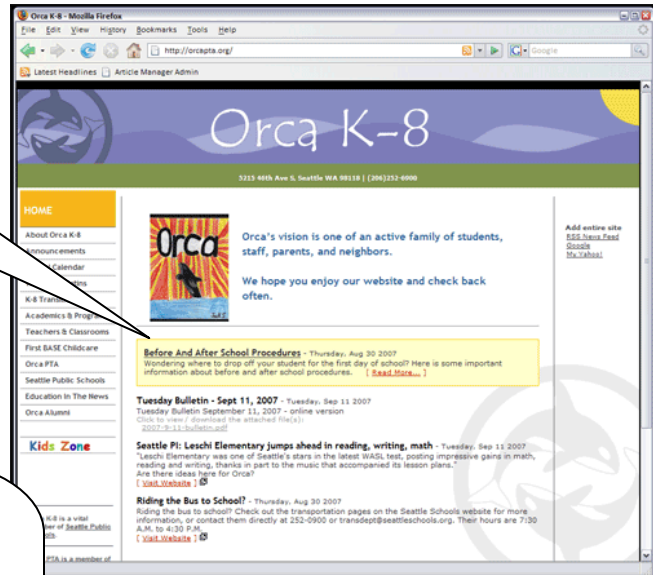


# Orca Website – What’s Where?

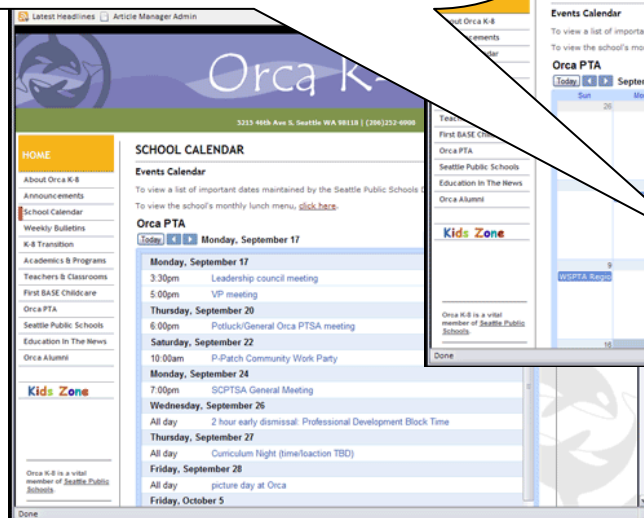
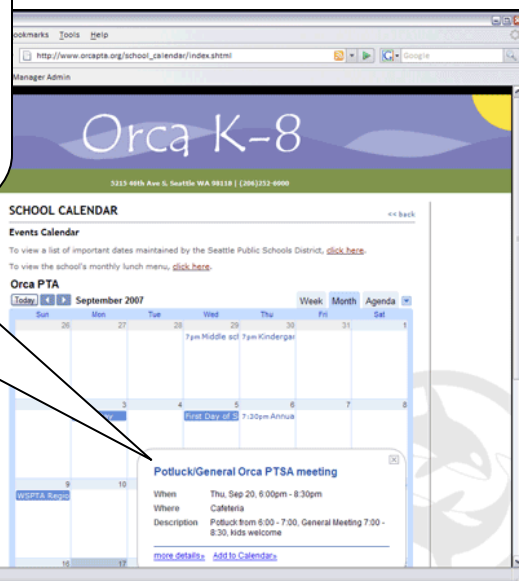
Important announcements will appear on the home page... with really important notices being highlighted!



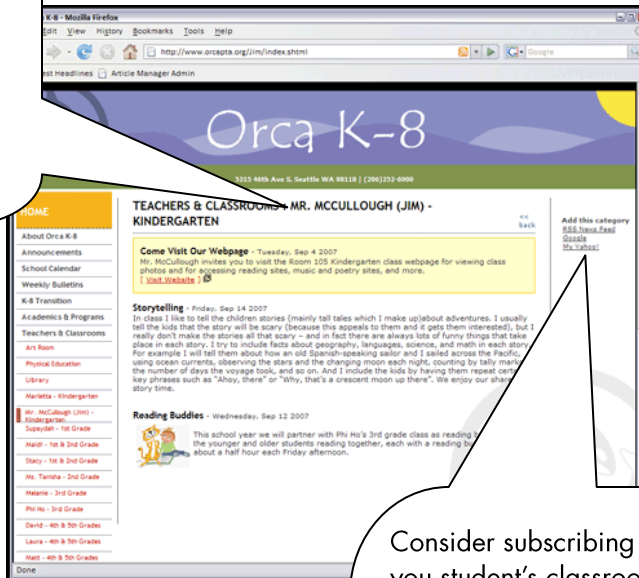
Use the school calendar to keep informed about meetings, activities, school plays, and lots more. It’s from Google, so you can even subscribe to get updates via email!

Some teachers may use the website to communicate information about classroom events and homework. Let your teacher know if you would like them to post information to the website.



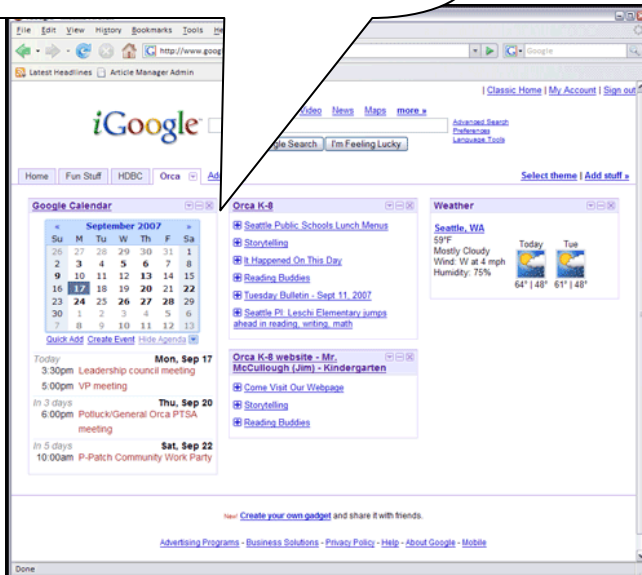
Consider subscribing to an RSS feed from your student's classroom page; you'll get notified when a new article (or homework) has been posted.

You can subscribe to an RSS feed for any specific category on the website, or consider subscribing to the RSS feed on the home page and see all the changes as they happen!

Many applications support RSS feeds including:

- Outlook 2003 & 2007
- [Firefox](#) (free Mac & Win Web Browser)
- [Thunderbird](#) (free Mac & Win Email Client)
- Google's iGoogle (via any web browser)

If you set iGoogle ([www.google.com/ig](http://www.google.com/ig)) as the home page for your web browser, and subscribe to the Orca Calendar and RSS feeds, then you'll always be up to date with everything happening at Orca!
